Comment: Epic Resources Ltd was incorporated in late September 2010 to earn an interest in the Quartz Hill project from Cazaly Iron Pty Ltd, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Cazaly Resources Ltd. Epic could earn a 75% interest in the project by completing 2,000m of RC drilling within two years and by paying Cazaly \$125,000 and 625,000 Epic shares. Contingent on Epic listing on the ASX the company issued a prospectus for the IPO of 15 million shares at \$0.20/share to raise \$3 million. Oversubscriptions amounting \$1 million would be accepted. The IPO closed in early February 2011 oversubscribed and the company was admitted to the ASX.
